Things to know about unemployment insurance during the COVID-19 pandemic.

- If you have lost your job due to no fault of your own, you can apply for unemployment insurance. You can apply online at kcc.ky.gov/career or by calling (502) 875-0442.
- Unemployment in Kentucky pays a percentage of your prior wages, with the minimum payment of \$39 per week and maximum payment of \$552 per week.
- Under current Kentucky law, you can receive unemployment for up to twenty-six (26) weeks.
- If you are denied unemployment benefits, you have the right to appeal but must do so in writing within fifteen (15) days of the postmark date of the denial letter.
